**AIR JAMAICA CONTINUES SERVICE TO GRENADA,
EXTENDS SALE FARES**

MIAMI – July 29, 2010 – Air Jamaica has announced the continuation of its nonstop service between New York (JFK) and Grenada. The airline’s schedule currently offers four weekly flights to Grenada, and starting September 6, 2010 the fall schedule will offer two flights per week to Grenada.

The fall flights to Grenada will operate on Wednesdays and Saturdays.

- Flight JM94 departs New York (JFK) at 12:40 a.m. and arrives Grenada at 5:40 a.m.
- Flight JM95 departs Grenada at 6:40 a.m. and arrives New York (JFK) at 11:40 a.m.
